### Keynote Speaker: Simine Vazire, Ph.D.

Associate Professor in the Department of Psychology Director of the Personality and Self-knowledge Lab at UC Davis.

She received her B.A. from Carleton College and her Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin. Before joining the faculty at UC Davis in 2014, she held positions at Washington University in St. Louis, and the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences at Stanford University. In addition to her research on people's self-knowledge of their own personality and behavior, she studies the research methods and factors that affect the validity and replicability of psychological research. Professor Vazire co-founded the Society for the Improvement of Psychological Science (SIPS), which aims to encourage open, reproducible science; she has served as chair of the SIPS executive committee and is currently a member of the senior editorial team of their journal Collabra: Psychology.
