  - 77% off employers and 87% of hiring managers look for Teamwork skills with diverse groups
  - 87% look for the ability to effectively work in teams
- o What do I mean by effectively?
  - Can you apply the knowledge and skills from your courses to your career?

## • WHAT IS A TEAM?

#### A TEAM HAS...

- A shared collective identity
- Common goals
- o Interdependence in terms of assigned tasks or outcomes
- o Distinctive Roles within the Team

## WHAT MAKES A GOOD TEAM?

- o They commit to decisions and plans of action
- o They trust one another
