Minions /minims/ are the many fictional yellow creatures that appear in the Despicable Me franchise, which started with Despicable Me (2010), and are characterized by their unique language and childlike behavior. They are also the official mascots of Illumination Entertainment, a division of Universal Studios. Following Comcast's purchase of NBCUniversal, they have even been described as being a corporate icon for Universal and Illumination's parent company, Comcast, on par with Disney's Mickey Mouse.[1]

Characteristics [edit | edit source]

The Minions are small, yellow, melodious henchmen shaped like pill capsules who wear overalls and goggles and have one or two eyes. They mostly speak incomprehensible gibberish, which is partly derived from other languages, including Bahasa Indonesia, French, English, Italian, Spanish, and Hindi.[2][3][4] Although seemingly nonsensical, the English-sounding dialogue is dubbed differently for every country, in order to make the sounds somewhat recognizable. [5] They have the most ordinary of names, with Kevin, Stuart and Bob being the names of the lead trio in Minions, and Mel being the leader of the Minions in Despicable Me 3.[6][7]

Minions, the 2015 animated feature film, shows that they have existed since the beginning of life on Earth, and want, above all else, to serve the most terrible of villains. [8] In the 2010 short film "Banana", the Minions are revealed to have an uncontrollable craving for fruits, especially bananas.





Minions is a 2015 American 3D computer-animated comedy film,^[1] serving as a spin-off/prequel to the Despicable Me franchise. Produced by Illumination Entertainment for Universal Pictures, it was directed by Pierre Coffin and Kyle Balda, written by Brian Lynch, and produced by Chris Meledandri and Janet Healy.^[2] The film stars the voices of Coffin (as the Minions, including: Kevin, Stuart and Bob), Sandra Bullock, Jon Hamm, Michael Keaton, Allison Janney, Steve Coogan, and Jennifer Saunders with the narration provided by Geoffrey Rush. It was first foreshadowed in the end credits of Despicable Me 2 (2013), where Kevin, Stuart, and Bob, three of the Minions, are seen auditioning for the film.^[3]

Minions had its premiere on June 11, 2015, in Leicester Square, London, and went into general release in the United States on July 10, 2015. [4] Critical response was mixed: some critics praised the comedic aspects of the film and the performances of Bullock and Hamm, [5] while also felt that the title characters were not able to carry the film on their own, and that the villains were flatly characterized. The film has grossed over \$1.1 billion worldwide (outgrossing each of the Despicable Me films), making it the 11th highest-grossing film of all time, the 2nd highest-grossing animated film, and the highest-grossing non-Disney animated film. [6] A sequel is announced to be released on July 3, 2020. [7]






